

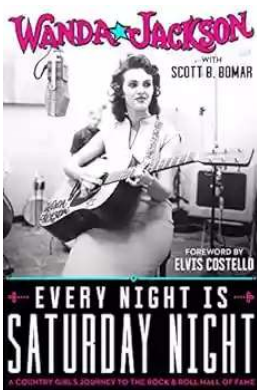

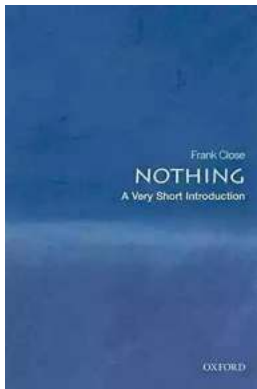


Wanda Jackson's debut single, "You Can't Have My Love," reached the Top 10 while she was still a sixteen-year-old high school student. often releasing singles with country on one side and rock on the other during her decade-and-a-half tenure on Capitol Records.

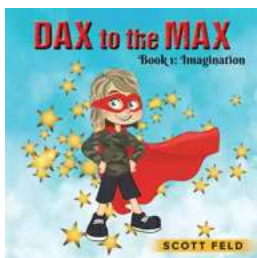
