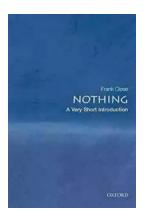

Cameroon is located in Central Africa on the Atlantic and is home to all of the continent's main climate zones: sea coast, mountains, rainforest, savannah and desert. Unfortunately, the country is difficult to travel to and tourism plays only a minor economic role.
