

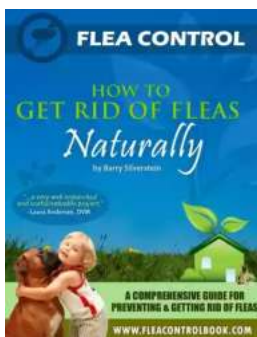

- The more exposure of sunlight will get rid of sand fleas from your surroundings.

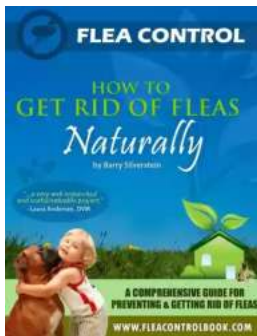
