Australia has developed a high proportion of endemic creatures due to its long geographic isolation. Of the more than 700 bird species in Australia, almost half are only found in Australia. On the mainland alone, 14 areas have been recognized as Endemic Bird Area (EBA) by BirdLife International, including the rainforest area of northern Queensland. habitats. For their protection, several hundred national parks have been established, but in Australia national parks are also used extensively as recreational sites for the human population. 65 wetlands fall under the Ramsar Convention. Australia is also the destination of many migratory birds, some of them from areas as far away as Siberia or Alaska. 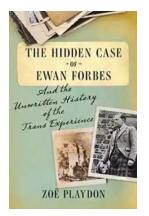

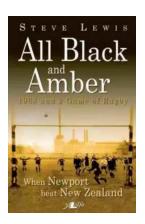

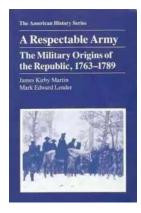
