the Creation ... In short, they are “about me” but they also are about everything else: everything that still matters in our lives.



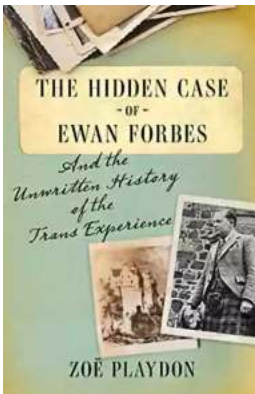
