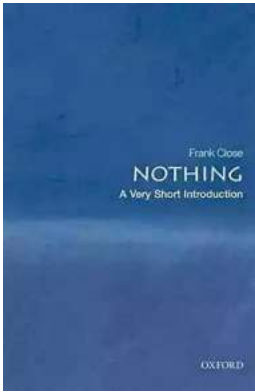
Only in The History of Astronomy Smith speaks of The Invisible hand as the follows:
