first prominent black lawyer and a renowned civil rights attorney who always fought for the underdog.

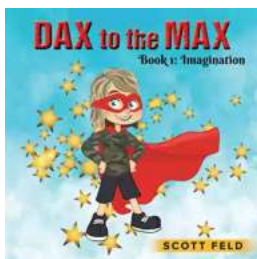
