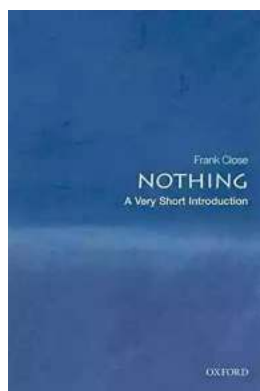

How to judge the performance of a product manager has always been a challenge. We manage many things, but we control precious few thing. There is a

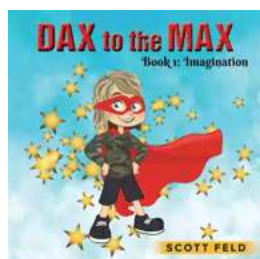
