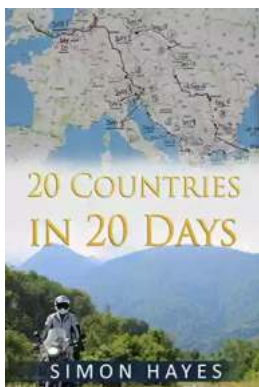

The final stretch of the journey takes riders through the mesmerizing landscapes of Anatolia. Riding through valleys, mountains, and traditional Turkish villages,

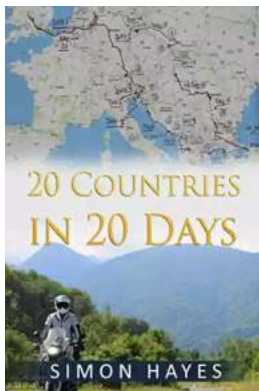
riders witness the beauty of the unspoiled countryside and interact with friendly locals along the way.

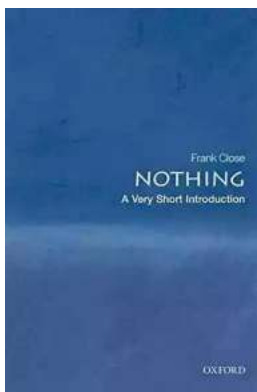
