

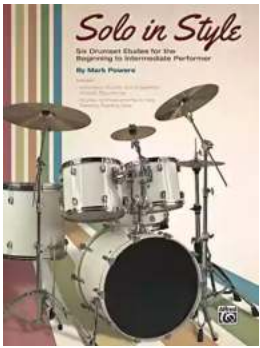

2. Jazz Swing Essentials



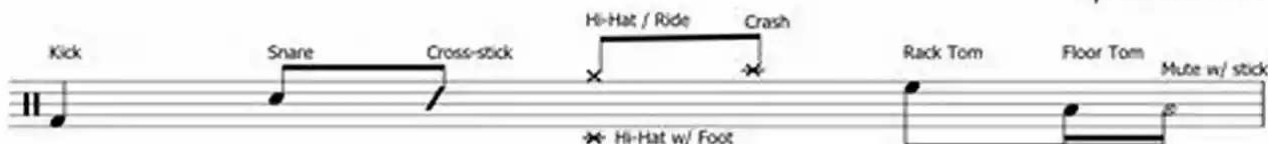

The Latin drum beats in this list come from mostly Cuba and Brazil with a few styles from other countries. In general, Latin music is dance music. This means it has a pulse, usually on the half note, that dancers can feel amid the layers of syncopation.

Tip: Feel the half note as an internal pulse. Sometimes the groove accentuates the half note, so it's not hard to feel. Also consider the call and response nature of the rhythms -- one measure usually says something and the next one responds. That's why the rhythms are written in mostly two measure chunks.

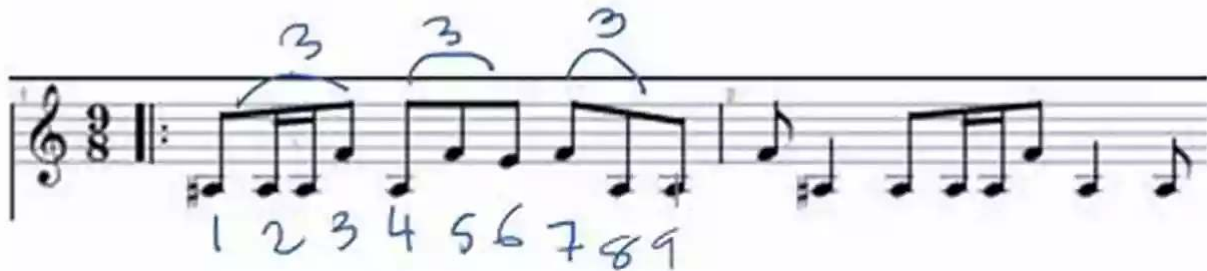
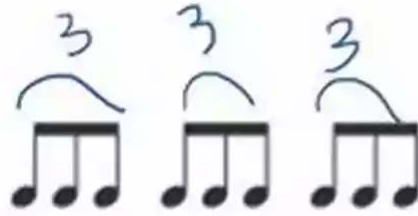


The cymbal pattern can be played on whatever sounds good -- the ride, hi-hats, on the snare with a brush, or even a shaker.
