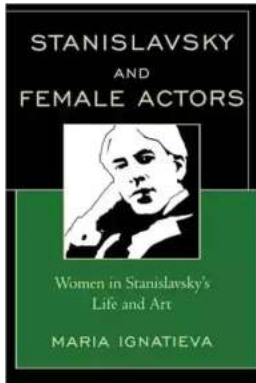

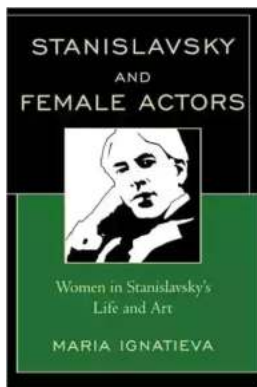

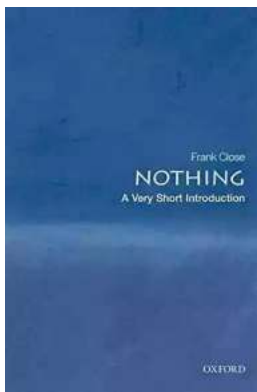

Every single artistic endeavor in Stanislavsky's life was achieved in close collaboration with female partners. 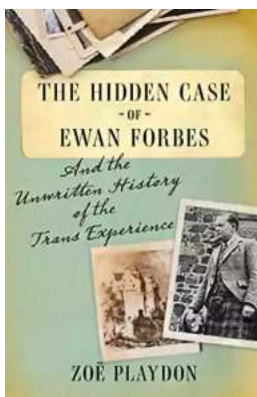
