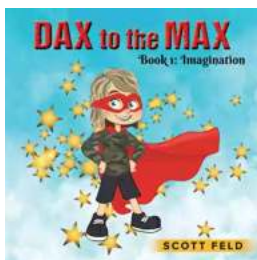
Tennessee Williams's first novel
