

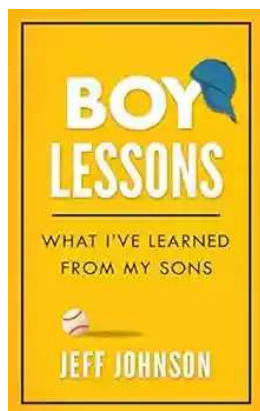
What I've Learned From My Sons

Exploring the World Through their Eyes

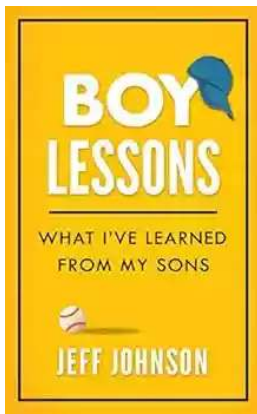

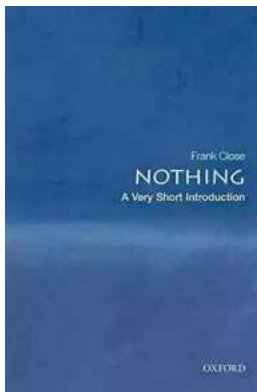

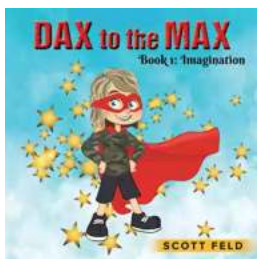
matching volunteers with seniors in need. He was the Republican candidate for Minnesota governor in 2014 and 2018.
